The Vision and Strategy:

- Create and agree upon a purpose for an effective, growing community aligned with the vision and strategy above.
- Develop and agree upon a “game plan” that excites and inspires the Core Team about how to achieve that vision of community.
- Develop and agree on a set of guidelines—how you will work together.
- Meet as Core Team monthly.
- Choose a liaison to be in communication with Pachamama Alliance Team, monthly.
- Host local/regional gatherings following local Pachamama Alliance programs (ATD/GCI/Drawdown), inviting participants to join your Community.
- Collaborate with other groups/organizations to cultivate a partnership of mutual benefit and growth.
- Use Pachamama Alliance tools and resources supporting this strategy: the Symposium, the Game Changer Intensive, Drawdown, using the Global Commons; adding your events, reporting on events, creating and maintaining your community page, and accessing online resources.

WHAT CORE TEAMS CAN COUNT ON THE PACHAMAMA ALLIANCE FOR:

- Models/templates for core team visions, game plans, and guidelines.
- Personal coaching and trainings (online and in-person) to build the skills and effectiveness of the Core Team and community.
- Effective and updated educational programs, particularly the Awakening the Dreamer Symposium and Game Changer Intensive, to grow the community.
- The Global Commons. An Online resource for community effectiveness and engagement.
- Effective partnerships with national movements for powerful game-changing systemic change.
